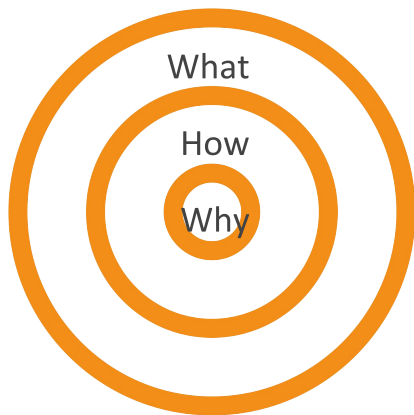

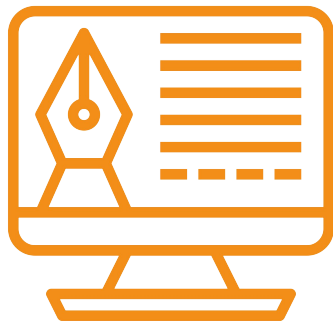

# Judging criteria

Each project will be judged on the following elements:

- **Compelling** Connection with the audience, engaging, organisation, makes us want to know more
- **Technical skills** Lighting, sound, special effects, graphics, transitions, shots, enhancements
- **Creativity** Imagination, originality
- **Theme** Yours (explained) or ours

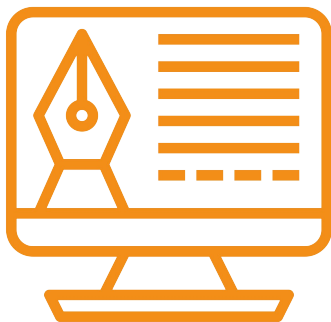

# A teacher's story

## TOP TIPS FOR TEACHERS

Spend time exploring what the theme means before using any digi equipment

When will the projects be completed? Our children complete all tasks in lunch times

Who is participating? Whole class or those with a passion?

All of our projects start with pencil and paper plans - and lots of talking

Have a clear direction before using any digi equipment - is the task achievable for children to complete independently?

Keep group size manageable

Spend time learning HOW to create projects - how to record, camera angles, digital photography layering etc (this may not be related to the Digi Awards theme)

Editing is a big part of the process - I always make the due date a couple of weeks before they are really due to allow time for editing

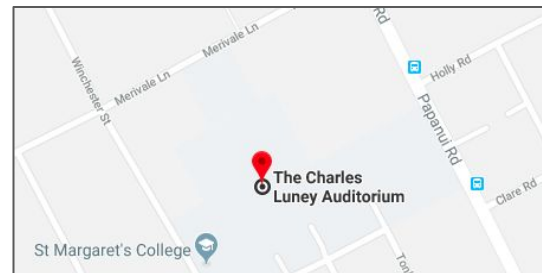


# DigiAwards celebration evening

# Considerations

- Student names in full on entry form and in the project being submitted.
- Provide a unique name for each entry: Is it easy for judges to tell difference between multiple entries from the same school?
- Please ensure the name on the entry form is the same as the name on the entry.
- Ensure the entry reflects the theme: To what extent does this need to be explained in the entry form?
- Teacher involvement: How much is too much?
- Check the [terms and conditions](#) and get permission from whānau/caregiver/s to have their children's photos taken.

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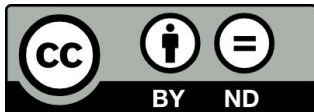

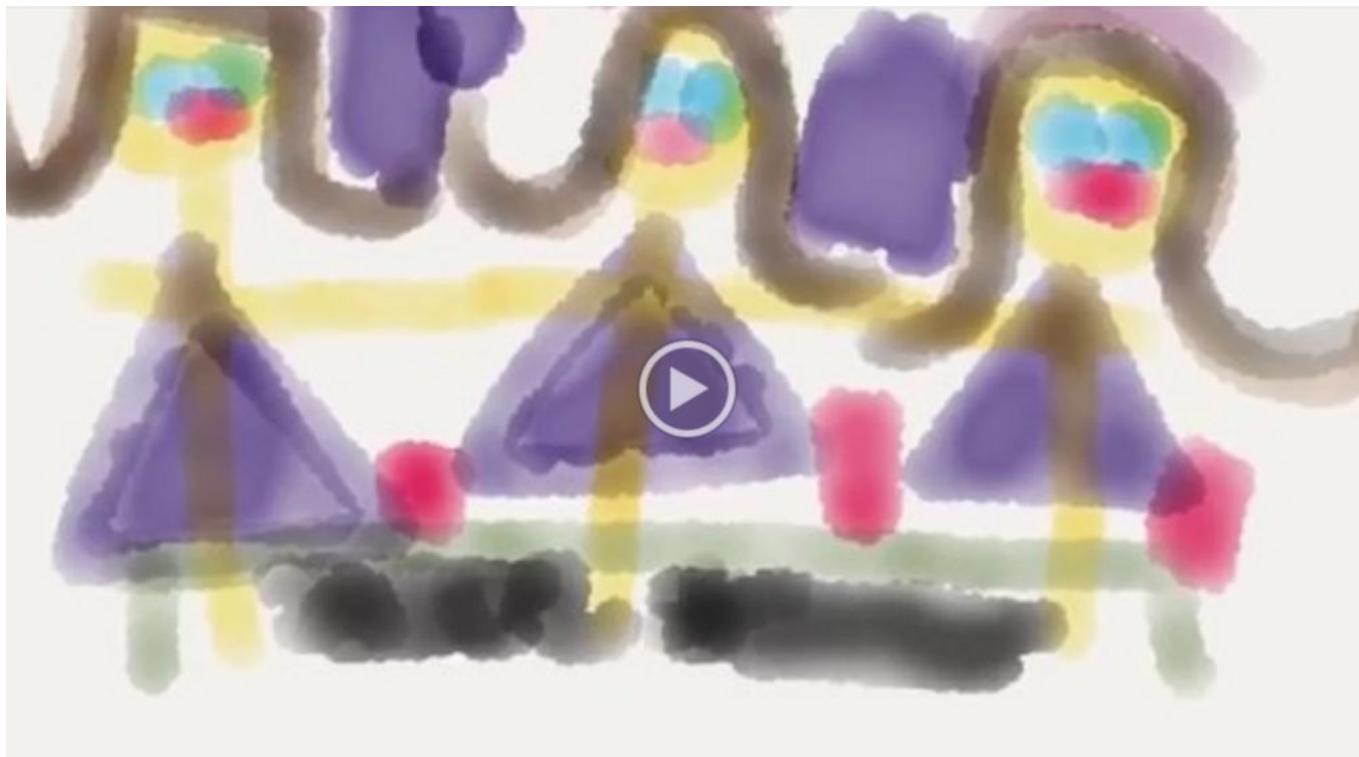
